**FORMAT:** Select shot, you bring your own 4-person team

**REGISTRATION:**

- Entry fee is \$150 per player, Corporate (\$1,000), Gold (\$1,500), Diamond (\$2,500), and Platinum (\$5,000) team sponsorships available.
- If you do not register as a team-of-four your name(s) will be placed on a waiting list and we will try to assign the required number of players to round out your team as they become available. Or, you will be assigned to a team as places become available.
- The Pro Shop staff will maintain the waiting list. Please leave your name and phone number.

**FLIGHTS:**

- There are two flights - Championship and First Flight. Teams will be flighted following the tournament. The lowest scoring 50% of all teams and all ties will be placed in the Championship flight, the remainder in the First Flight.
- Awards are presented to the first and second place teams in both flights. In case of a tie, a scorecard playoff defined by the tournament director will determine the winning team.
- First and second place teams in both flights will receive the same awards except that the first-place team in the Championship Flight will receive championship golf shirts, and their names engraved on the Woody Trophy.

**FOOD & BEVERAGES:**

- Beverages will be served throughout the day, and a meal will be provided after each round.

**HOLES-IN-ONE:**

- \$15,000 in cash will be awarded for a hole-in-one on select par three holes. One half of the \$15,000 prize will be awarded to the Lawrence Hahn Foundation.
- Limited to amateurs.

**CONTESTS:**

- Longest drive and straightest drive contests will be held during the course of play.
- Closest to the pin on each par three
- Putting contest before and during course of play
